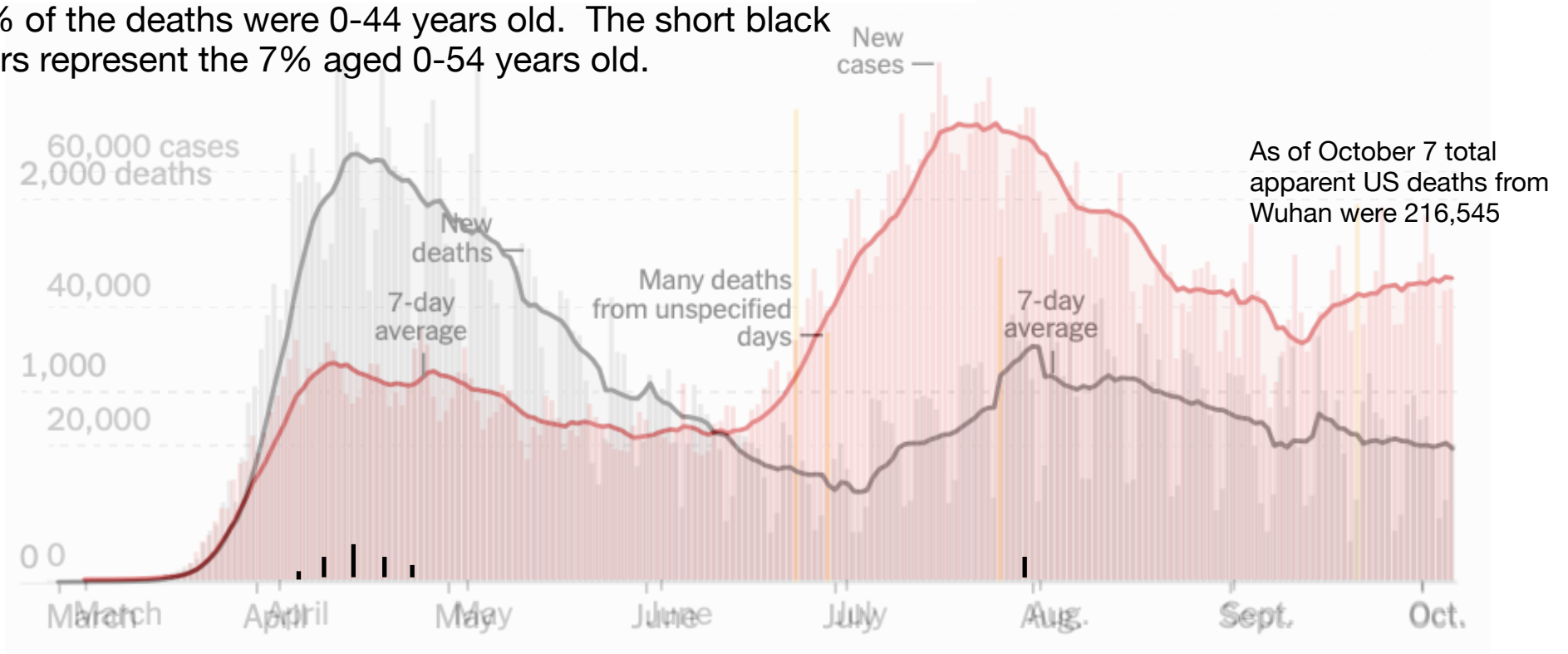


US Daily Cases (Red) & Deaths (Black) 2020

About 93% of all of the deaths were 55 to 85+ years old.
 About 4% of the deaths were 45 to 54 years old and
 3% of the deaths were 0-44 years old. The short black
 bars represent the 7% aged 0-54 years old.



US Cases (10s of thousands) versus Deaths (thousands) overlaid in time. The deaths show a Northern Temperate “spike” (March-May) and a Southern Equatorial “hump”(July-Oct). The spike is the Northeast US mostly NY and NJ with some New England and mid-Western states. The hump is mostly the Southern tier states and California. Note the discrepancies of cases to deaths in the spike and hump areas. And look at September where cases are increasing while deaths decrease.
